The Department of Agriculture has evidence that on or about **March 8, 2011**, you or your organization committed the following violation of Federal Regulations:

- 2.50(a)(1) Time and Method of Identification....**failure to properly identify all dogs on the premises
- 2.75 (a)(1) Records: Dealers and Exhibitors....**failure to maintain records on all dogs on the premises
- 3.1 (b) Housing Facilities General....**failure to maintain housing facilities and surrounding areas free of any accumulated trash and other discarded material
- 3.1 (c)(1)(i) Housing Facilities, General....**failure to maintain surfaces free of excessive rust
- 3.1(c)(1)(ii) Housing Facilities, General – DIRECT –**failure to construct and maintain primary enclosures free of jagged edges and sharp points
- 3.1(c)(3) Housing Facilities, General....** repeated failure to spot-clean daily and sanitize once every two weeks
- 3.4(c) Outdoor Housing Facilities....**failure to maintain surfaces in contact with animals impervious to moisture
- 3.6 (a)(1) Primary Enclosures....**failure to construct and maintain primary enclosures structurally sound and in good repair
- 3.6 (a)(2)(ii) Primary Enclosures – DIRECT –**failure to construct and maintain primary enclosures so they protect the dogs from injury
- 3.6(a)(2)(xii) Primary Enclosures....** failure to construct the suspended floor of the primary enclosure of metal strands that are either greater than 1/8 inch in diameter (9 gauge) or coated with a material such as plastic or fiberglass
- 3.6 (c)(1)(iii) Primary Enclosures....**failure to provide a minimum of six inches of space above the tallest dog in the primary enclosure when it is in normal standing position
- 3.9(b) Feeding....**failure to clean and sanitize self feeders at least once every two weeks
- 3.10 Watering....**failure to provide fresh potable water

Titles 7 & 9 Code of Federal Regulations were promulgated to help prevent the spread of animal and plant pests and diseases and assure the humane treatment of animals. Since violations of the regulations can have serious and costly impact detrimental to the public interest, you are warned of this violation. Any further violation of these regulations may result in the assessment of a civil penalty or criminal prosecution.
